MODOS will take place online during September and October 2020. There are four training modules and participants can choose which ones to take part in.

Who is this training programme suitable for?

MODOS is suitable for all businesses but is particularly relevant for those from the following sectors: construction and the built environment, food, retail, manufacturing, textiles and fashion, electronics, plastics and packaging. It is aimed at micro, small and medium size enterprises.
